First Aid Equipment & Facilities			
Item	Location		
First Aid Kit	Carried by Team Manager for each Crosspool FC team		
Defibrillator	There is a AED defibrillator on site. For Access Code, contact 999; the AED is registered with The Circuit network and maintained by Crosspool FC.  The on-site AED defibrillator is located on the side wall of the garage of the former caretaker's property, which is the building nearest to the vehicle access gate on Myers Grove Lane (main & sole site access).		
	The next nearest accessible AED device is:  * PW Autos. 32 Myers Grove Lane, Stannington, S6 5JG  * Co-Op Supermarket, 2 Oldfield Road, Stannington, Sheffield, S6 6DT. Both require a pin code (obtainable from emergency services)		
Stretcher	No stretcher at this site		
First Aid Room	No designated first aid room but the clubhouse property can be used if required. Contact the Crosspool FC team manager for assistance.		
	Vehicle Access Routes		
For Ambulance	Myers Grove Hub site is only accessible via road on one end of Myers Grove Lane only. Google reference: Stannington Community Association (community centre building which shares access to the site) will direct the emergency vehicles to the site.  The main vehicle gates on Myers Grove Lane to the site should be already unlocked when the site is used by an authorised user.  The Crosspool FC car park gates should also be accessible when used by official / authorised users.		
For Air Ambulance (helicopter)	On match day, it is likely that the car parking spaces are full of cars. If an air ambulance needs to land on one of the football pitches, to provide emergency care for the casualty, all players and spectators should immediately evacuate the landing area/ pitch except for the first aider(s) tending to the injured person(s).

CARDIAC ARREST INSTRUCTIONS		
ASSESS THE PERSON		
Danger - Check there is no danger before checking the person.		
Response - Check whether they are responding.		
Airway - Check their airway is clear.		
Breathing - Check if they are breathing.		
• Circulation - Check for a pulse or that the heart is pumping.		
• Stay calm!		
DIAL 999 (or 112)		
Tell the operator that you suspect a cardiac arrest.		
PERFORM CPR		
<ul> <li>Kneel by the casualty and put the heel of your hand in the middle of their chest.</li> </ul>		
• Put your other hand on top of the first. Interlock your fingers making sure they don't		
touch the ribs.		
• Keep your arms straight and lean over the casualty. Press down hard, to a depth of		
about 5-6cm before releasing the pressure, allowing the chest to come back up.		
Do not give rescue breaths if untrained.		
LOCATE DEFIBRILLATOR		
Ask a helper to obtain a defibrillator if available.		
Do not stop CPR to look for a defibrillator yourself.		
CONTINUE CPR UNTIL:		
Ambulance arrives and paramedics take over.		
A defibrillator is about to be used.		
• The person becomes responsive.		
You are exhausted - swap with a helper every 1-2 minutes
